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

Our group has had an excellent experience with Dynapulse devices for both research and clinical care. We have used DP5000A ambulatory BP devices since 2000 and have found it to be a reliable instrument that not only provides accurate ambulatory BP data but also offers the possibility of hemodynamic assessment through the DAC. We have also used the DP500G device for research projects since 2002. It has proven to be a very versatile device, with excellent performance in a wide variety of patient groups, including hemodialysis (Motiwala et al, Blood Press Monitoring 2005: in press) and chronic kidney disease (Yarlagadda et al, Am J Nephrol 2005; 25: 451-8). Overall, we are most pleased with the data obtained through the Dynapulse devices in our unit.
